- 1) Preparing a roadmap & timeline for proposed adoption of SAMARTH in phases for process automation in University of Hyderabad as desired by Ministry of Education.
- 2) Identify Module Officers where necessary and ensure smooth functioning of SAMARTH
- 3) Identify & co-ordinate with SAMARTH, New Delhi for finding and feasibility customization, feature requests and integration with UoH's website as deemed necessary, through Nodal Officer, UoH.
- 4) The committee should meet every month and/or as need arises and complete the implementation of all modules in the University within one year.
