COVID-19 - NOTIFICATION

Sub: COVID-19 – Extended Lockdown till 30th June, 2020.
Ref: 1. Orders of MHA No.40-3/2020-DM-I(A) dated 30th May 2020.

In continuation of the earlier Notifications dated 23rd March, 04th April, 14th April, 3rd May & 18th May of 2020, it is brought to the notice of all stakeholders that the **University of Hyderabad shall continue to be under Lockdown till 30th June, 2020 vide orders first and second above.** The essential services shall remain operational during this period with Safe Distancing while working. Following are the **brief additional guidelines** on functioning of the University:

(i) Six Day Week:

As per Notification No.UH/E-II/2020/63 dated 28.05.2020, the University shall remain functional for Six Days in a Week and with 33% attendance until further orders. All Academic and Administrative Units may revise the rosters accordingly and ensure that each batch of employees attend their duties for a period of one week (6 days) and such batch of employees may be ensured to continue their 'work from home' until their turn comes in the next roster cycle to contain spread of virus. Security will ensure strict compliance of 33% attendance in permitting the staff into the University except essential services, as approved by the Units.

(ii) Institutional / Individual Responsibility:

While the Institution is trying its best in taking all necessary possible precautions to contain the virus, onus lies on every individual (Teaching / Non-teaching staff including Outsourcing workers and Consultants) to ensure their own safety with necessary precautions during this pandemic.

(iii) Team COVID-19 :

A Team will be notified for 'On-site Spot Verification' to ensure whether the employees (Teaching / Non-teaching including Outsourcing and Consultants) are following guidelines issued by the University and by the Gol / State Governments from time to time with regard to social distancing, wearing masks, sanitization of hands, use of Arogya Setu App and gatherings during lunch, common places of the University etc. Necessary action will be taken in violation of the guidelines issued by the University.

(iv) Entry of Outsiders:

The Resident Employees (Teaching / Non-Teaching) are requested not to allow any outsider / relatives to enter into the Campus during the present period of pandemic, unless it is very urgent with necessary permissions from Chief Security Officer.

(v) Servant Quarters:

The Faculty and Officers concerned are requested to certify the details of persons staying in their Servant Quarters and ensure their safety by following necessary precautions as per the guidelines issued by the University and the Gol from time to time.
