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Syllabus for Assistant Security Officer

- Physical Security Controls Access control, materials movement, identification systems, frisking etc.
- 2. Security Management / Organizing security department Identification of security agency, identifying the security needs, recruitment of security personnel.
- 3. Electronic Security Familiarization of Bio-metric access cards, handheld / door frame metal detectors, boom barriers, surveillance camera operations, etc.
- 4. Intelligence gathering, surveillance, basic knowledge of vigilance and its functions.
- 5. Fire Safety Use & Maintenance of portable fire extinguishers, installation & identification of layout fire safety equipment, training subordinates on fire safety.
- 6. Dealing with Emergencies Fire accidents, bomb threats, staff/labour unrest, gheroeing the executives, suicide cases, terrorist attacks, kidnapping of executives, hostage release.
- 7. VVIP Security / Executive Protection Escorting, identification of safe route, traffic arrangements within the campus sanitization of VVIP location.
- 8. Crime Theft, trespass, sabotage, investigation of theft & report writing.
- 9. Security & Law A few important sections of IPC (Indian Penal Code) such as private defence, theft, trespass, kidnapping, rash & negligent driving, assault, criminal intimidation, impersonation, cheating, mischief etc.
- 10. Computer Security Physical security measures, basics in information security such as hacking, email abuses, internet misuse.
- 11. Documentation of Security Maintenance of occurrence book, visitors register, material movement registers, identification / vehicle log books.
- 12. Directing and controlling security operations, liaison with internal and external agencies such as Police, IB, Fire etc.
